

## FRANKLIN STREET SCHOOL PROJECT Donor Recognition Opportunities

### School Rooms Sponsorship

**Gift Range: \$25,000 to \$100,000**

There are six major program rooms in the School. Each will be named for a principal, teacher or graduate of the school who made significant contributions to Cape May's African American community. A donor or group of donors who sponsors a classroom will be honored with a plaque near the door to the classroom that reads, e.g.:

*The C.R. Thompson Classroom  
Made possible by the generosity of The Smith Family  
Joe and Jane Smith, Jacqueline Smith Kline, and Joe Smith, Jr.*

### Window Restoration Sponsorship

**Gift Range: \$15,000**

There are 20 large paned windows in the front of the school. A donor who sponsors the cost of a window restoration will be honored with a window name plaque.

### Donor Recognition Panel, Front Foyer

**Gift Range: \$10,000 and up**

Individuals and businesses donating gifts of \$10,000 and up will be listed on a tile-framed panel prominently displayed in the School's first floor hallway. Designed by West Cape May artist, Susan Ross, the panel mirrors the style of the front foyer mural described below.

### Cape Island Community Mural

**Gift Range: \$1,000 to \$5,000**

CCA has commissioned local artist, Susan Ross, to design a mosaic mural installation welcoming visitors to the Franklin Street School Community Cultural Center. The mural is a panorama of Cape Island, stretching from the Atlantic Ocean to the Delaware Bay. Individuals and businesses who contribute a minimum of \$1,000 can add their names to donor tiles on the wall below the mural.
